## VISIT TO TRELICK TOWER & THE CHELTENHAM ESTATE

Led by: Emma Dent-Coad

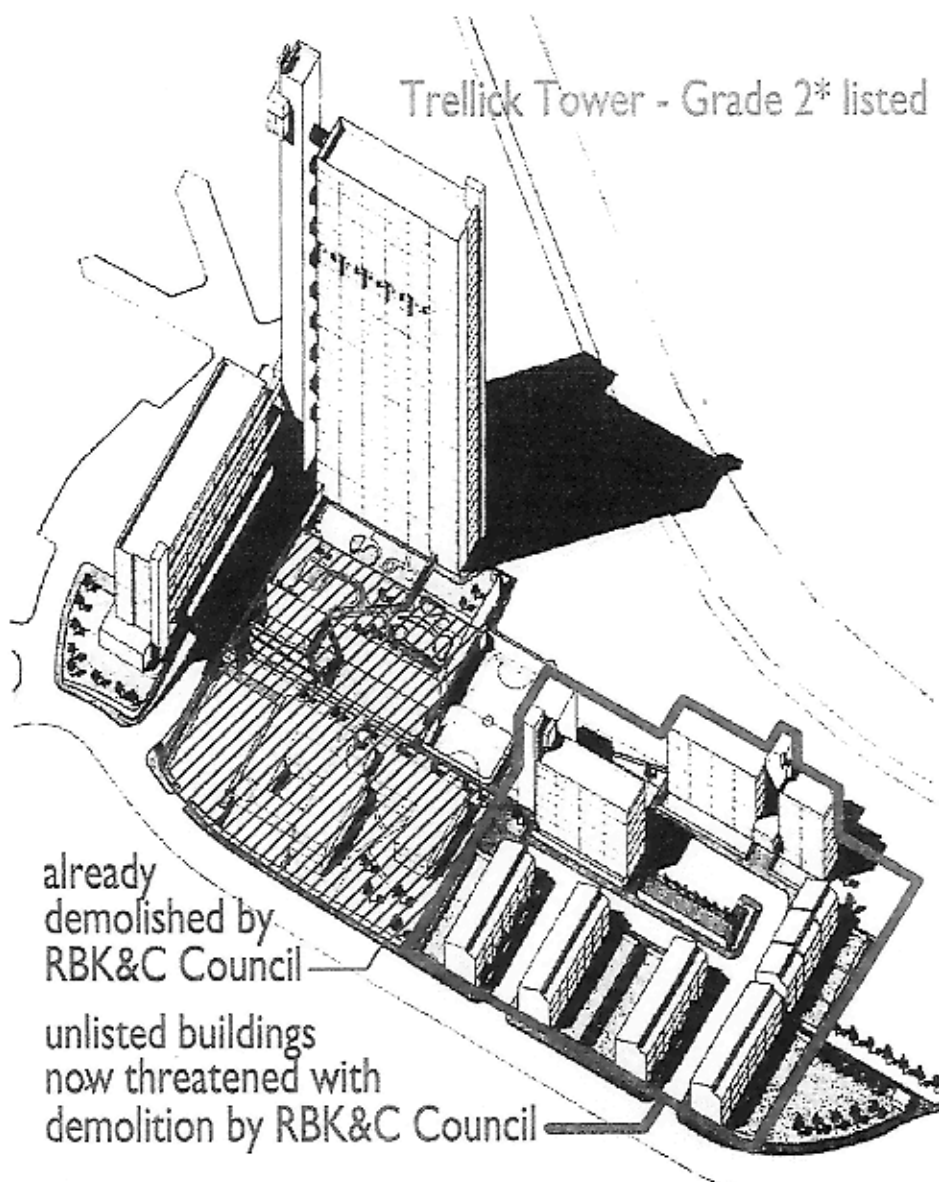
The visit will include a look at  
The history of the area and the  
construction and early days of  
the Cheltenham Estate. The day  
will start with a talk and questions  
from docomomo co-chair James  
Dunnnett who worked with Erno  
Goldfinger at the time and who  
has written extensively about  
this iconic project.

We will visit parts of the building  
but not necessarily residents with  
'immaculate 70's interiors' as the  
focus is on broader issues than  
just the conservation of interiors.

We will then look at the current  
situation- with some buildings  
demolished, some saved  
and a major restoration under  
way and how the Council and  
national funding situation may  
put the buildings at risk, with  
listing only covering the main  
tower and smaller tower.

Emma Dent-Coad is a local  
councillor and on the board of  
the TMO which manages the  
buildings for the council. It is  
hoped that the visit will extend  
the interaction started during the  
previous visit a few months ago.

Finally we will look at possible  
futures for the estate and how  
local people have already been  
working to make a plan to put  
to the Council for support and  
Action.
